## INFORMATION CLAUSE FOR UNIVERSITY CANDIDATES

I declare that, in accordance with Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27.04.2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Journal of Laws of the EU. L. of 2016, No. 119, sir. 1) (hereinafter: "RODO"), I have been made aware of the following information regarding the processing of personal data at the WSEI University:

- 1. The administrator of the personal data is WSEI University, 4 Projektowa St., 20-209 Lublin.
- The Personal Data Inspector is Mr. Leszek Gonka, who can be contacted via email email: iod@wsei.lublin.pl or by phone: 81 749-32-33. The Personal Data Inspector can be contacted on all matters concerning the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights related to the processing of personal data.
- Personal data will be processed for the following purposes: to carry out the recruitment procedure for studies at the WSEI University and, in the case of admission, to document the course of studies.
- 4. Personal data may be made available to entities authorized by law.
- 5. Personal data will be stored at the University:

a) In the case of non-admission of a candidate to the university - for a period of 6 months from the date of completion of the recruitment or

- b) in the case of admission of a candidate to the university for a period of 50 years from the date of graduation of the Student.
- 6. Processing of personal data may be carried out by the Administrator, depending on the category and purpose of personal data processing, among others, on the basis of:
  - a) consent to the processing of personal data expressed by the data subject (pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) RODO);
  - b) transfer of data by the user necessary for the purpose of performance of contracts e.g., with regard to the processing of personal data for the provision of services (pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of the RODO);
